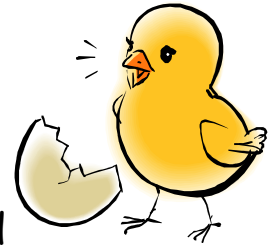
Easter Training Arrangements

Mission Accomplished

Our mission to deliver services to our Swimmers and the Community with funds From the Local Network Fund has been successful. Using funds gained we:



- Provided twice weekly Land Training sessions to 40+ of our upper squad Swimmers.
- Furnished those Swimmers with a comprehensive exercise guide.
- Delivered Free Community Swimming Lessons to 12 Children from 5-7yrs, resulting in some of the Learners signing up for our own programme of Learner lessons.
- We put ten young people through their ASA Level 1 Teachers Course.

All this in the midst of the enormous challenges the Club has had to face with the relocation of our training due to the pool refurbishment. Well done to the hard working Committee Members, Coaches, Assistant Coaches and Parent Volunteers who made it all happen.
