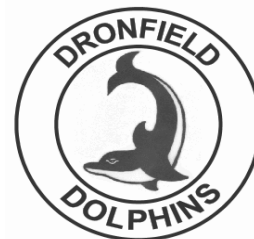

### SPEEDO LEAGUE 2006

After much deliberation, it has been decided not to enter this years SPEEDO League competition which runs in October, November & December of every year.

The Committee looked at all aspects of this annual event, and made the decision not to enter.

These Galas cost the Club £900 last year in Coach travel, as the region we Swim in took us as far as Wisbech last year. The distance bumps up Coach prices, and the Committee felt this was a major factor in deciding whether to enter or not. Another contributory factor in making this decision was the lack of commitment to swim from the Swimmers themselves. The team managers select their strongest team, and then due to Swimmers been otherwise engaged, have to take a weaker side, which in turn makes our position as a Club within the League vulnerable. The Team Managers are always grateful to any Swimmer who steps in to swim at short notice, but this League requires a strong team on entry. This is unfair on the Swimmers who are totally committed to this Club, and want to Swim to win!!

The Committee also discussed the possibility of re entering next year, and intend to be flexible about our part in the League.
